

# Ultimate Checklist For Travel With Digital Devices

## Equipment necessary for recharging devices

- Research which of your devices require a voltage converter & borrow/purchase what you need.
- Research which receptacle plug adaptors you will need (varies by country)-purchase or borrow them.
- Purchase a multi-plug universal outlet device.
- Buy or borrow a rechargeable backup power pack that can be used with all of your devices.

## Digital camera

- Put extra batteries in your camera case.
- Take extra memory cards.
- Pack cable and/or connector to download to laptop or tablet.

## Smartphone

- Check with your provider about using your data plan in foreign countries.
- Know how to connect to Wi-Fi before you leave.
- Know how to turn off Cellular Roaming.
- Turn on your Password Protection option.
- Make sure you know your password.
- Install apps like "Find My iPhone" on another device you are taking.
- Make sure you have your charger with you.
- Research what you have to do to recharge your phone in a different country.

## Tablet

- Turn on your Password Protection option.
- Make sure you know your password.
- Know how to connect to new Wi-Fi networks.
- Install apps like "Find My iPad" on your smartphone.
- Make sure you have your charger with you.
- Research what you have to do to recharge your tablet in a different country.

## Computer

- Have it in an easily accessible part of your carry-on luggage because in many countries you will have to take it out to go through airport security.
- Make sure you have your charger.
- Know how to access a new Wi-Fi network.
- Research how you will recharge your computer in a foreign country.

## Wearable devices like Fitbits and digital watches

- Figure out how you will recharge them before you go.
- Be prepared to take it off when you go through airport security.
- Pack your charger.
